Cooperative Bidding St. Lawrence-Lewis BOCES Onondaga-Cortland BOCES

Co-Ser: 601

This service, provided through cross contracts with Onondaga-Cortland BOCES, St. Lawrence-Lewis BOCES and Eastern Suffolk BOCES, provides districts with the opportunity to participate in group purchasing to effect savings on equipment, supplies, etc.

Planning Services Management State Aid Planning Service QUESTAR III BOCES

Co-Ser: 646

This service is provided through a cross contract with the Questar III Board of Cooperative Educational Services. Estimates of state aid and state aid reports are prepared for participating school districts based on data provided by the school districts. The yearly service includes: assistance in generation and auditing of state aid forms; regional workshops; hot line service; assistance in understanding conceptual framework of state aid in New York State; maximizing state aid; analysis of legislative proposals for state aid to education; legislative monitoring; state aid projections; school district financial comparisons (regional, county, statewide); assistance with presentation material (board, public).

Shared Business Office (FEH BOCES)

This service, provided through a cross contract with the FEH BOCES, provides a shared Business Office, offering full business services to districts including Business manager, payroll, accounts payable and accounting.
