Teacher of the Deaf/Hearing Impaired

Champlain Valley Educational Services is a part of the BOCES system in New York State. They provide special education services to multiple school districts. The Teacher of the Deaf (TOD) position is an itinerant position. There are currently three TODs on staff who provide services to deaf and hearing impaired students in kindergarten through 12th grade. TODs provide academic instruction and support to students, maintain and monitor equipment including: hearing aids, FM systems, and cochlear implants, as well as provide consultation services to regular education teachers.


Among the wide variety of services we offer, CVES offers a number of teaching positions in various

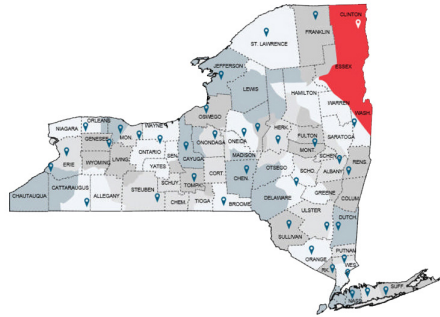

BOCES Profile

Champlain Valley Educational Services (CVES) is located on the northeastern corner of New York State on Lake Champlain in close proximity to Montreal, Vermont, Lake Placid and Albany.

CVES serves approximately 13,500 students from 16 component school districts in Clinton, Essex, Warren and Washington counties, an area stretching from the Canadian border to the Lake George region (2,343 sq. miles). It has five campuses located in Plattsburgh and Mineville, NY.

Clinton and Essex counties provide many cultural and recreational opportunities. Enjoy swimming, fishing, boating and sailing in nearby Lake Champlain, or skiing and snowboarding at Whiteface Mountain. You can hike the Adirondack Mountains, canoe down the Saranac or AuSable rivers, go camping and more; we are a dynamic 4-season recreational area.
