


Try This If You're Having Trouble With Chromebook:

How to connect a chromebook to wifi and fix it if it does not work the first time.


1 – Click on the clock area in the lower right hand corner of the screen.

2 – Click on the area below the wifi symbol where it says: **Not connected** No networks.




3 – Click on CVES BYOD

4 – Click on the White notification box that opens stating: **Connect to Wi-Fi network** The Wi-Fi network you are using (CVES BYOD) may require you to visit its login page.



5 – On the webpage that opens enter the username and password for the students CVES account (as found in SchoolTool in the User Defined tab and select CVES Computer Accounts).


Do NOT add the @cves.org at the end of the user account.



You should now be connected to the internet on the chromebook. If for some reason you are not follow the steps below:

6 – Click on the area below the Wi-Fi symbol.

7 – Click on the CVES BYOD network



8 – Click on Forget then return to step 1 and try again.
