

Commercial Driver's License (CDL) Class B

CDL-B 200A

CV-TEC's Class B CDL Program is a 30-hour course leading to a commercial driver's license that allows holders to drive certain types of commercial vehicles. The course is designed for individuals with limited or no experience driving a Class B commercial vehicle. Commercial vehicles that can be operated with a Class B driver's license include, but are not limited to, straight trucks, dump trucks, cement trucks, refuse trucks, delivery trucks, tow trucks, household and commercial moving trucks, grocery delivery trucks, box vans, or large buses. Having a Class B license permits you to drive a gross vehicle weight of 26,001 pounds or more. This gross weight limit includes any combination of vehicles and cargo. Completion of the CDL Class B program leads to eligibility for Department of Motor Vehicle testing and licensure.



Python 1: Programming Concepts

Python 101



This course covers programming fundamentals for someone looking to start writing code. Some of the programming concepts we will discuss include variables, data types, operators, loops, functions, classes, and file i/o. The course will focus on learning the primary skills that all programmers need in most languages. Although we will be talking about broader concepts, we will reinforce them through real-world applications in Python. At the end of the course, students will have a strong foundation to continue learning Python or any other programming languages. They will also be able to apply the concepts to help with everyday tasks.

Some roles that this course may help someone gain the skills for include help desk technician, programming internship, quality assurance analyst among others. (72 course hours)
