



## CV-TEC Student Driver, Passenger & Walk-Off Campus Guidelines

### Eligibility:

To have driving, passenger, or walk-off campus privileges, students must be a senior or post-secondary adult student, must be in good standing—exhibiting proper professional behavior, punctuality, attendance, and assignment completion.

### General Rules:

- Driving to CV-TEC is a privilege, not a right. Violations may result in revocation without appeal.
- Off-campus parking is prohibited.
- Students must arrive and leave with their district's bus schedule.

### Driving Requirements:

- **Completed** application signed by: CV-TEC teacher, student, parent/guardian, home school principal, and CV-TEC principal.
- Submit copy of driver's license. (Further documentation may be requested by the principal.)
- Parking Permit must be affixed to the lower right corner of the driver's door window and expires at year-end.
- Vehicles must be secured and not left during non-school hours without permission.
- **Speed limit is 10 MPH.** Follow traffic rules and use designated entrances/exits.

### Disciplinary Action for Late Arrivals (Without Valid Excuse):

- 1st offense: 2-week suspension of privileges
- 2nd offense: Suspension until end of semester
- 3rd offense: Suspension for rest of school year

### Conduct Expectations:

- No loitering in vehicles or parking areas.
- Students report directly to classrooms on arrival and must leave immediately after dismissal.
- Vehicles may be searched with reasonable suspicion. Refusal = loss of privilege.
- No offensive symbols, phrases, or insignia on vehicles.

### Passenger Policy:

- Riding with other students is not permitted unless explicitly approved by driver and passenger parents and home school district principal(s).
- Unauthorized riders or transporters will face disciplinary action; drivers may lose privileges permanently.

### Note:

CV-TEC is not responsible for lost/stolen items. Vehicles may be towed if unregistered or illegally parked. CV-TEC reserves the right to search vehicles parked on school grounds with reasonable individualized suspicion. Searches will be done after informing the driver and or parent with said driver present. Failure on the part of the driver to allow an inspection will result in the loss of privileges.
